



GAS EMERGENCY RESPONSE GUIDELINES WH KELLY LTD

If you smell or hear gas escaping, seek help immediately and follow this guideline.

1. Switch off all machinery and remove all sources of ignition, including mobile phones if safe to do so.
2. Do not operate electrical or phone equipment within the area.
3. Evacuate the immediate area (at least 100 metres in the case of a transmission pipe) Gas sinks – so if in a trench- get out urgently.
4. Move to a safe area and call the fire service 111.
Know your site location so emergency services can find you.
5. Leave the damaged pipe to vent.
6. Call the NGC Emergency line 0800 802 332.
7. Stay clear of the area until you are advised that it is safe.
8. If the damaged gas pipe is a smaller diameter line call Sheldon @ Vector on 027 446 3642

DO NOT start any vehicles for removal

DO NOT attempt to extinguish ignited gas fires on your own

DO NOT try to cover the damaged pipe with any material, including digger buckets.
